

 - o To enter multiple interests at once, separate them using commas


Tip: Encourage students to be specific (e.g., favorite subjects, hobbies, dream careers, favorite sports teams)

Layout:


• Left Panel: ERB-style question display

Functionality:


• Students may ask clarifying questions at any time

Completing a Practice Question

- To support learning reflection, a pop-up module appears after every 5 completed questions. It celebrates progress and prompts the student to reflect with:
 - o "What did you learn from the problem?"
 - "A star rating for 'How was the conversation?"



Additional Tools and Settings


Access Point: Click on the User Initials (located in the top right corner)

Available Options:

- Profile Information
- Interest Management: Students can access Interest Management at any point to change, subtract, or add to their personalized interests.
- Practice History: In the 'Practice History' page, students can review past
 questions and conversations. Students may choose to look at completed
 conversations for review, or reengage with the tutor in 'In Progress' sections.
